She previously qualified as a Nurse for persons with Intellectual Disability, has a Diploma in Counselling and in 2011 completed her Master of Science by Research at Dublin City University. She has extensive experience in training professionals to Marte Meo Therapist

and Supervisor levels as well as training a wide variety of professionals to apply the Marte Meo method in services from birth to old age. She has worked closely with professionals in the field of Fostering and Adoption in implementing the Marte Meo method into elements of the fostering and adoption process Colette has supported agencies to develop Marte Meo supportive intervention packages eg Getting to know your baby pack. She has much experience at presenting workshops and conferences both nationally and in internationally

MARTE MEO IN FOSTER CARE is a video-based method that provides concrete and detailed information to Foster Parents to support the developmental needs of children placed in their care.

The objectives of using this method as a tool to support children who must leave their birth family are:

- To provide Carers with information on the developmental needs of the children coming into their care and provide opportunities for Carers to begin the attachment process appropriate to the needs of the child.
- To identify developmental gaps of the child and give information to Carers on supporting the social, emotional, intellectual and language development of the child in daily interaction moments.

The focus of this 1 day seminar will be to demonstrate the use of the method in the elements of fostering in order to support the attachment process in the new relationship, build on strengths, and influence positive outcomes for children in care.
